GYMNASIUM FLOOR PRESERVATION: Please do not slide objects across the hardwood floor. DO NOT SCRATCH HARDWOOD FLOOR.
TAPE/BALLOON POLICY: Tape is prohibited from use on the gymnasium floor and walls to prevent ruining surfaces. Helium balloons are prohibited inside building.
HEADPHONE POLICY: All electronic devices used in the exhibit space must have accompanying headphones to reduce the level of noise in the exhibit hall.
CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: No refunds will be issued for cancellations made after January 1, 2026. Cancellations made between November 1, 2025 and December 31, 2025, will incur a 50% service charge. Cancellations must be received in writing via email to info@crpa.com or val@crpa.com. Should CRPA cancel the show or the show be canceled due to a government shutdown (force majeure) your choice of either a refund or a credit for the 2027 showcase will be issued.
